FACT SHEET:

Tribal Electrification Program





The Tribal Electrification program will deliver zero emissions electricity to Tribal homes that lack access to electricity and or rely on fossil fuel appliances for things like cooking and heating. Tribal governments will receive both financial and technical assistance to help residents of Tribal communities transition homes to zero emissions energy systems as they electrify, as well as upgrade, retrofit and repair homes as necessary to allow for the installation of zero emissions energy systems.



By electrifying homes in Tribal communities residents will experience lower energy costs, as well as improved indoor air quality when gas appliances are switched out. Program funds will be made available in the form of direct spending, grants, contracts and financial assistance agreements.

Key Dates

The Bureau of Indian Affairs will release a notice of funding opportunity in **Spring 2023**. The notice of funding opportunity will explain what projects are eligible under this program, who can apply and what the eligibility criteria are.
